- The highly fuel-efficient aircraft: The Airbus A330neo consumes just over half a gallon of fuel per passenger, per 160 miles (2,1 L/100 km) well below the industry average.
- By cutting CO₂ emissions by 20 percent on the same routes, customers reduce their environmental footprint. In fact, the Airbus A330neo is the first aircraft in the world already certified to meet the 2028 CO₂ emission reduction targets.
- Our new aircraft not only operates economically and efficiently, but is also quiet: noise pollution at airports is reduced by up to 60 percent. Flying is therefore only half as loud as before.
- Advanced materials, new optimized wing, composite winglet and highly efficient engines.




